That is why we developed an Ultra Violet Light water purification system that is simple, adaptable, and portable, given to communities, free of charge, in developing countries without access to clean water. Where units have been installed and maintained, there has been a significant reduction in the incidence of water-borne diseases, especially in children.

This is what we are striving for. This is why we exist.

Commitment to Serving


Founders Judy & Jerry Bohl have been visiting El Salvador and Haiti for the past 20 years. While visiting they were given bottled water to drink, but were astonished to see the children drinking tap water that was known to be contaminated. Not ones to stand idly by, they immediately got to work in providing access to clean water.

Since 2007, more than 260 purifiers have been installed, providing 150,000+ people with access to clean water everyday.



Changing Lives - Our Results

- It costs \$5 per person to have access to clean water for 10 years.
- Families save \$428 per year by not using firewood to boil water for purification,
- A 95% average decrease occurred in incidences of diarrhea in purifier communities.
- With decrease in firewood use, there is significant reduction in carbon emissions and deforestation.

Meet Fabienne. Her parents worried if she would be able to attend school because she

had diarrhea every month due to the contaminated water in the community's well. Since the purifier has been installed in Thomazeau, Haiti, Fabienne has not missed a day in school and loves to learn.



\$1,050 - Install a **120 volt water purifier** in rural communities in Central America. Serves 600 people.



\$1,050 - Install a **240 volt water purifier** in rural communities in Africa and India. Serves 600 people.



\$1,800 - Install a **solar purifier** in remote areas without electricity, including Haiti. Serves 600 people.

Empower through Education

Education is the key to drinking clean water every time, erasing gastrointestinal infections, and improving the health and economic viability of communities.

Installing a purifier provides access to clean water to a community of 600 residents. However, providing access requires an educational component in order to change behavior and practices. Each community receives 2 training workshops prior to installation and an annual workshop to reinforce clean water and sanitation habits.

~HOW WATER PROMOTERS CARE~

1

Identify

Communities in need of a water purifier are identified

2

Accompany

Communities are educated on benefits of clean water and maintaining the water purifier

3

Install & Train

Purifier installation, training water committee on maintaining it, and clean water workshops

4

Monitor

Numerous purifiers are monitored and maintained throughout the year

- **Activities include:** personal building coach at the workshop, educational talk, lunch



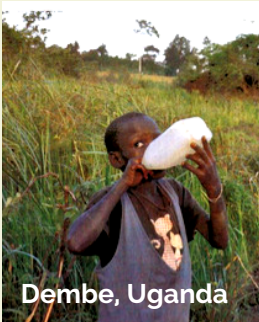

Dembe would walk a quarter mile each way to collect water for her family. Her mother

would boil the water for 20 minutes 4 times a day to purify the water. With the water purifier installed in Nebbi Town, Uganda, her family now saves time and money on purifying water.

Each community receiving a purifier also gets a 2-year supply of replacement parts.
