Clean Water for the World Recent Additions and Events

Clean Water for the World (CWFW) is a non-profit group based in Kalamazoo, Michigan. The group is committed to distributing water purification systems to villages and communities in developing countries that do not have a source of clean water. The systems cost about \$800 to build and equip. The purification units are built by volunteers. Clean Water for the World (CWFW) delivered 40 water purification units during our fiscal year from October 1, 2013 —September 30, 2014 . These units went to communities in El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, The Dominican Republic, Costa Rica, Honduras, Tanzania, India, and Uganda. These units were built by volunteers and delivered by many different volunteers from across the Midwest as well as other parts of the United States. In addition, several other communities were re-visited to see how the water purification units were working.

The picture at left is from a June 2014 Mission Trip to Ecuador by members of Centerpoint Church of Kalamazoo This is in a village called Gahuijon Alto, made up of about 200 Quichua people located at 12,000 feet altitude in the highlands of the Andes Mountains in the Chimborazo region. We installed their first unit in 2006. After problems with electricity, a second unit was installed. Subsequent visits from Centerpoint volunteers have focused on maintenance and education about the unit.

According to Todd, "With the unit in place, the boys have access to clean water, improving their health. They no longer will need to purchase bottled water for drinking. It provides both a health and economic benefit to the community!"
